### Tween Graphic Novel Book Club (Ages 9-12)\*

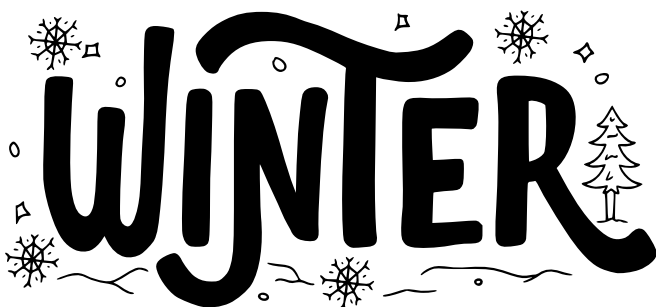
