Explore cultures and geography from around the world through trivia, games, crafts, and other hands-on activities. Registration is required and opens January 26.

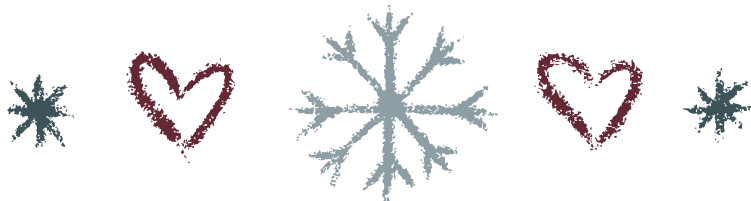
